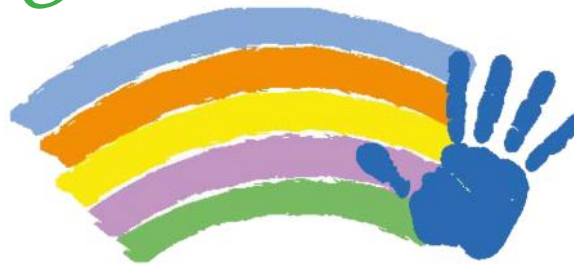

Aiding Children in Need

What does the Fund do?

The St George Children with Disabilities Fund Inc. is committed to supporting children in need and improving the quality of life of children and their families.

How much can I apply for?

The Fund has allocated \$50,000 to assist children with severe physical and intellectual disabilities.

Individual grants up to a maximum of \$5,000 are available. Partial grants can also be applied for. Unfortunately, we are unable to award a grant to every applicant due to the limits on funding.

When do applications open and close?

Applications open on 1st November 2017 and close on 30th November 2017.

Who can apply?

Families in the St George and Sutherland areas and those of students and ex-students of St George School are eligible to apply.

Criteria for funding

1. The Beneficiary must be an Australian Citizen or Australian Permanent Resident
2. The Beneficiary must be listed on a current Medicare card

What do I need to include with my application?

In addition to completing the application form in full, you will be required to include:

- a detailed breakdown of how you expect to spend the grant money, along with the names and contact details of any providers, if available
- a certified copy of the Applicant's Medicare card, listing the beneficiary.

If relevant, please include any medical or other documentation to support your application.

If I am successful, when will I be told?

Successful applicants will be notified by 5th December 2017 by email.

If I am successful, what are the next steps?

1. You will need to submit two quotes for any work that needs to be done, as outlined in your grant application.
2. Once the quote has been approved, you can arrange for the work to take place/purchase the item requested.
3. The Fund will handle all monetary transactions on your behalf. Invoices need to be in the name of St George Children with Disabilities Fund Inc.
4. You will need to submit a report by 30 June 2018. We will provide you with information about this if you are successful in receiving a grant.

Is there a time limit on spending the Grant money?

If you are successful, the Grant must be spent by 30 June 2018. Whatever money has not been spent by then will be forfeited.

What can be funded?

1. Speech Therapy, Physio Therapy (Items covered by Medicare cannot be applied for.)
2. Respite/Equipment
3. Minor home renovations
4. Items that improve the beneficiary's quality of life
5. Vehicular modification
6. If you would like to use the grant money for something that is not listed above, please contact Garry Morris OAM to discuss this.
